Anyone who would like to submit a poem with their registration (by April 15th) will be eligible for the President's poetry award of \$100 dollars. This is a new competition that I have decided to sponsor. It will be judged by an outside referee prior to the festival. Poems can be any form or style, 24 line limit.

The price for a double room is \$119 and be sure you identify that you are with the Utah State Poetry Society to get this rate. The price includes a hot breakfast. No meals will be provided this year so the price for the festival is \$40.00. Within walking distance of the hotel are over 25 restaurants. There are 70 shops, movie theaters, and spas surrounding the hotel as well.

The other advantage to this facility is that you can ride Frontrunner to get there. You get off at Farmington Station and there will be a shuttle to take you over to the hotel where the festival is being held.
